## FOUNDATION PROGRAMMES BEFORE UNIVERSITY STUDIES IN SLOVAKIA

One-year full-time programmes are specially designed to prepare international students for their entry to higher education in Slovakia.

**Duration:** one academic year **October 3, 2011 – June 4, 2012**

**Enrolment deadlines:** **June 15, 2011** /non-EU residents/  
**September 15, 2011** /EU residents only/

### Foundation Programme A: Slovak Language Preparation

**Extent:** 700 lessons, i.e. 4 - 6 lessons daily - the Slovak language competency on the level B2 is recognized by Slovak universities.

**Tuition fee:** 4,000 EUR (including VAT)      Registration fee: 50 EUR

### Foundation Programme B: Slovak & English Language Preparation

**Extent:** 960 lessons totally, i.e. 6 lessons daily

- 700 lessons of the Slovak language - the Slovak language competency on the level B2 is recognized by Slovak universities.
- 260 lessons of the English language  
The English language competency on the levels B1 or B2.

**Tuition fee:** 5,200 EUR (including VAT)      Registration fee: 50 EUR

**Attention:** The stated tuition fee is valid for one person in the study group of 5 – 10 students. In case of a smaller number of students in a group, the tuition fee is stated ad hoc.



## FOUNDATION PROGRAMME A

### SLOVAK LANGUAGE PREPARATION

### BEFORE UNIVERSITY STUDIES IN SLOVAKIA

**Goal:** This one-year full-time programme is specially designed to prepare international students in the Slovak language for their entry to higher education in Slovakia and to reach the required language proficiency on the level B2.

**Duration:** one academic year (8 months)

**Date:** October 3, 2011 – June 4, 2012

**Extent:** 700 lessons (per 45 minutes)

- The programme starts with 6 weeks of extra-intensive language study – 30 lessons a week, i.e. 6 lessons daily;
- Afterwards an intensive language study – 20 lessons a week, i.e. 4 lessons daily;
- A final examination assessing the Slovak language proficiency on the level B2 – a certificate of the Slovak language competency on the level B2.

**Tuition fee:** 4,000 EUR (including VAT)

**Registration fee:** 50 EUR

#### Entry requirements:

- Completed online enrolment form;
- the letter of motivation including concrete information on the chosen degree programme;
- a scan of relevant documents approving the completed education (the secondary/high school leaving certificate/diploma or Bachelor degree diploma or Master degree diploma including the transcript of records);
- a scan of the passport (personal details page).

## FOUNDATION PROGRAMME B

### SLOVAK & ENGLISH LANGUAGE PREPARATION BEFORE UNIVERSITY STUDIES IN SLOVAKIA

**Goal:**

This one-year full-time programme is specially designed to prepare international students in Slovak and English languages for their entry to higher education in Slovakia and to reach the required Slovak language proficiency on the level B2.

**Duration:**

one academic year (8 months)

**Date:**

October 3, 2011 – June 4, 2012

**Extent:**

960 lessons (per 45 minutes)

- The programme starts with 6 weeks of extra-intensive Slovak language study – 30 lessons a week, i.e. 6 lessons daily;
- Afterwards: - an intensive Slovak language study – 20 lessons a week, i.e. 4 lessons daily;  
- an English language study – 10 lessons a week;
- Final examinations assessing the language proficiency in Slovak on the level B2 and in English on levels B1 or B2 with certificates of the language competency on respective levels.

**Tuition fee:**

5,200 EUR (including VAT)

**Registration fee:**

50 EUR

**Entry requirements:**

- Completed online enrolment form;
- the letter of motivation including concrete information on the chosen degree programme;
- a scan of relevant documents approving the completed education (the secondary/high school leaving certificate/diploma or Bachelor degree diploma or Master degree diploma including the transcript of records);
- a scan of the passport (personal details page).
